



Information for Prospective Technical Assessment Candidates

The Register for Architects was launched in November 2009. A reasonable period of time has passed to allow those who had been using the title 'architect' but were not on the register to regularise their positions. The RIAI has this week launched a Compliance Information campaign. The campaign involves the issue of letters to all of those identified as possibly using the title architect without being registered. The list of recipients of the letter was drawn up using research including published information in directories and websites as well as enquiries received from members of the public. Recipients of the letters will also receive information on how to register, as well as a template form of undertaking to confirm that they will no longer use the title architect should that be their preferred course of action.

The Technical Assessment contact list has not been used in drawing up the list of those to receive letters, although some people on the contact list who have separately shown up as part of the research exercise will have received letters. All of those on the Technical Assessment contact list are invited to review the information, published here
