TALK & GUIDED WALK OF WESTPORT - Sunday 3rd of October 14:00pm –Wyatt Hotel.
Westport in parallel with most Irish rural towns has experienced an unprecedented amount of development over the past decade. This illustrated talk and walk by Town Architect to Westport Simon Wall, traces that development from Section 23 (sea side resort) tax designation through the Celtic Tiger period, and beyond!
Incorporating the Towns computerised 3d planning tool and its unique relationship with Google Earth. This event commences with a 40min illustrated talk in the Wyatt Hotel followed by a 30min walk of the town core.

Public Lecture - FREE

David Rudlin, Urbed – “New Life for Small Towns”

The small town is at a crossroads today. From its historic role as the focus of economic and social life, many are facing key challenges brought about by changes in contemporary lifestyles, suburban sprawl, increasing car use and emerging shopping habits. David Rudlin, Director of URBED was co-author of New Life for Smaller Towns – A Handbook for Action in the 1990s and more recently was author of the Towns Chapter in the Academy of Urbanism's first book Place, Place, Life (particularly relevant since Westport is shortlisted for this year's AoU awards). David will describe the pressures facing smaller towns and what can be done, drawing on URBED's experience of working with many local communities in the last two decades.

Followed by open discussion
