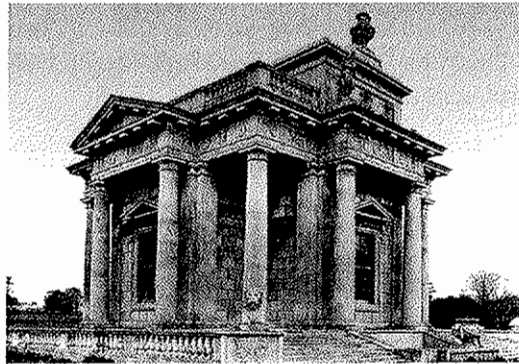

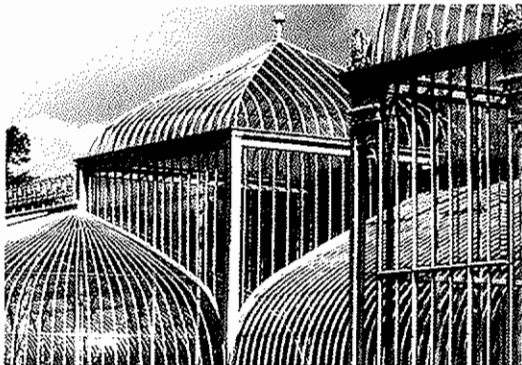

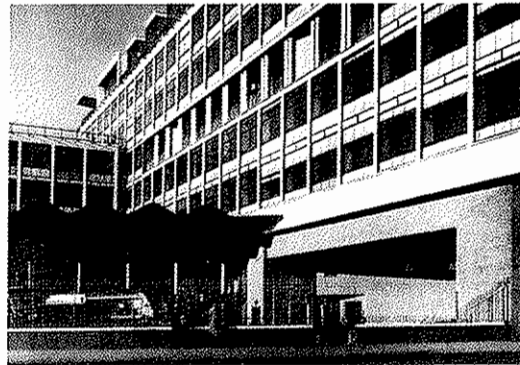
1. Red House (Uniacke House), Youghal, 1715

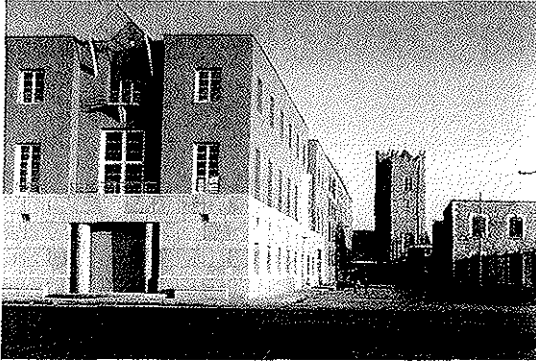

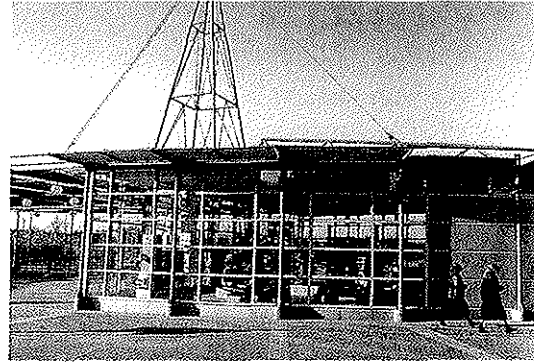
